FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

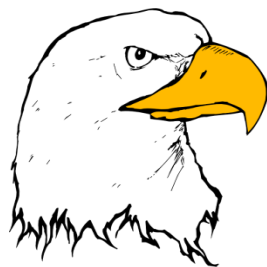

School News

Uniform Policy: At St. Edward School, the uniform dress code promotes a positive atmosphere that reduces competition and directs attention to learning and growing in an environment that supports school values. The staff of St. Edward relies on parents to be the first monitors of the student dress code.

As a reminder, uniforms must fit properly. Pants must be worn at waist level. Jumpers and skirts should not be significantly higher than the knee and may not be rolled up at the waist. All shirts must remain tucked in. Oversized or tight-fitting clothing are not permitted. All clothing should be labeled with the student's name. Girls are encouraged to wear shorts under their jumper/skirt due to the various activities that are done at school.

Parents, Guardians, and Grandparents please do not park in the handicap section when picking up or dropping off your students; even if you leave someone waiting in the car. We have families here who need the handicap spots but are unable to use them. Please leave them available for those who need them. Thank you for your understanding.
